

Thereafter, he continued to serve as the Governing Council member until his passing.

Brother Lee's service extended beyond the borders of Malaysia. He actively participated as the Coordinator of Airlifts, bringing aid and support to Myanmar, Sri Lanka and Vietnam under the Asian Council's mandate. I joined FGBMF in 2005 and in my short time

getting acquainted with him, I was amazed by his Christ-like character of having no anger, always being happy, smiling and easy-going member of the Governing Council. His meekness in FGBMF fellowship is legendary. I always have high regards for him as a wise and cool spiritual father. His advice to me has always been simple and yet profound in opinion. In every interaction I had with him, he radiated warmth and kindness, leaving a trail of tranquility wherever he went. His life was a testament to simplicity, humility, and unwavering faith although God has blessed and prospered him much.

His life was a testament to his faith. As a retired architect by profession and a devoted member of the SIB church, he found his true calling in serving the Lord in FGB and his community. I always remember his saying that the benefit of joining FGB is "giving". I have known and worked with Gee Koon since when I joined FGB in 1988. We attended many FGB conventions and been on quite a few holidays together. I have collected quite a few memories from him.

First to spring to mind is when he picked me up in a taxi to go to the airport. As I got in, he handed me a cheque. I looked at it and saw my name on it and it was for RM5,000. I asked him what it was for. He said that a couple of weeks before, the Holy Spirit told him to buy me a laptop to help me in my FGB teaching seminars. He did not respond but the previous day the Holy Spirit actually told him to give me RM5,000. Since it was so specific, he had to obey.

Gee Koon always sought to listen to and obey the Holy Spirit. This was evident when he and another brother covered the RM100,000 shortfall for the Sabah student conference for 1,500 students and 100 teachers. Also, when he and two other brothers paid for the rather large field in Light House Kapit to be cemented over with reinforced concrete.

Generous and ever willing to give to the Kingdom of God, he was very frugal on himself. Once I told him of a pop-up store selling discounted Dockers. He insisted and I took him there. He was most delighted to buy a pair of Dockers at a good discount.

It seems to me that he didn't know how to get angry. One day I told him I was irritated by him because even in the face of a situation in which anyone would be upset, he would just shrug his shoulder. As a result, he brought a calming effect at our board meetings. He was a man of few words. He actually could sit through an entire three-hour meeting without saying anything. But when he felt he needed to say something his words were usually what we needed to hear.

Gee Koon was a man of great faith. He held on to the belief and the necessity that the church must be united. He wished for the various

denominations and churches to set aside their doctrinal and theological differences and just to focus on Jesus and the Holy Spirit. He believed very strongly that unity in the Kingdom depends on all Christians yielding themselves and obeying the Holy Spirit. This belief and hope never departed from him. He also always held an unwavering belief that revival in Malaysia will start from the East. His support for our Borneo Malaysia projects is just too many to recount. These two wishes of his are yet to be fulfilled but he believed that they shall.

On Wednesday 10 April Dr Lee Chee San, Joshua Ong and I had lunch with him. Chee San brought a river patin from Kapit and got it steamed and some braised pork tendon, two of his favourite dishes from this restaurant. He was alert and engaged with us for more than 90 mins. It was so good to see him so well and I thought he would be with us for quite some time to come. That he passed into glory, less than three days later, in the early hours of Saturday 13 April was the grace of God.

This is the best memory he created for me. A peaceful, non-fearful, in fact joyous, transition from this life into the next. At the Holy Communion just before lunch he declared with us, "Christ has died, Christ has risen and Christ will come again." Indeed, he will come again with Jesus. In the meantime, he is enjoying the presence of God in his new abode.

He was our elder statesman and spiritual advisor. We will miss his physical presence but the values and wisdom he imparted to us will continue to guide our leaders for years to come.


